The Denali CARE Team can help with:



Insurance Coverage

Benefits verification to understand coverage and resources to support prior authorizations (PAs), reauthorizations, denials, and appeals.



Financial Assistance

Identifying and connecting eligible patients with affordability resources, including enrollment in the AVLAYAH copay program.



Treatment Coordination

Assistance with treatment logistics, such as finding an infusion site or transitioning to home infusion when appropriate.



Information and Resources

Support to answer any questions, share educational materials, and connect individuals to relevant community resources.

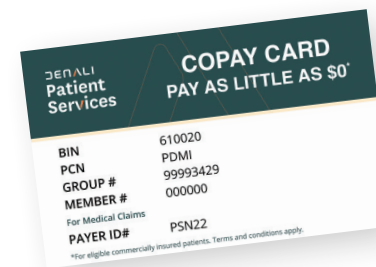
Once enrolled in Denali Patient Services, your patient will be connected with a dedicated Denali CARE Partner who will support them with information about coverage, affordability, logistics, and the infusion process. Denali CARE Partners can also provide one-on-one support and check-ins on request, share educational resources, and answer any questions about program services and access.



Account Leads

Account Leads are your local, dedicated support resource, providing access support materials to your practice and answering questions about a Denali approved product. They can also provide you and your staff with information about the insurance approval and reimbursement process.

Insurance Delays or Changes

The Denali CARE Team can help identify options and resources during coverage transitions to keep treatment on track.

Treatment Decision

Once the decision is made to initiate treatment, the access process begins—with confirmation of coverage and the PA. HCPs can begin gathering key documentation for the submission.

Coverage Review & PA Submission

Denali Patient Services initiates a benefits investigation to confirm coverage and identify any PA requirements. When submitting the PA, consider including a Letter of Medical Necessity to support clinical rationale and expedite approval. If the PA is denied, we have a resource available to help with submitting an appeal.

If there is no existing coverage policy for AVLAYAH, consider submitting an Exception Letter to request coverage based on medical need.
